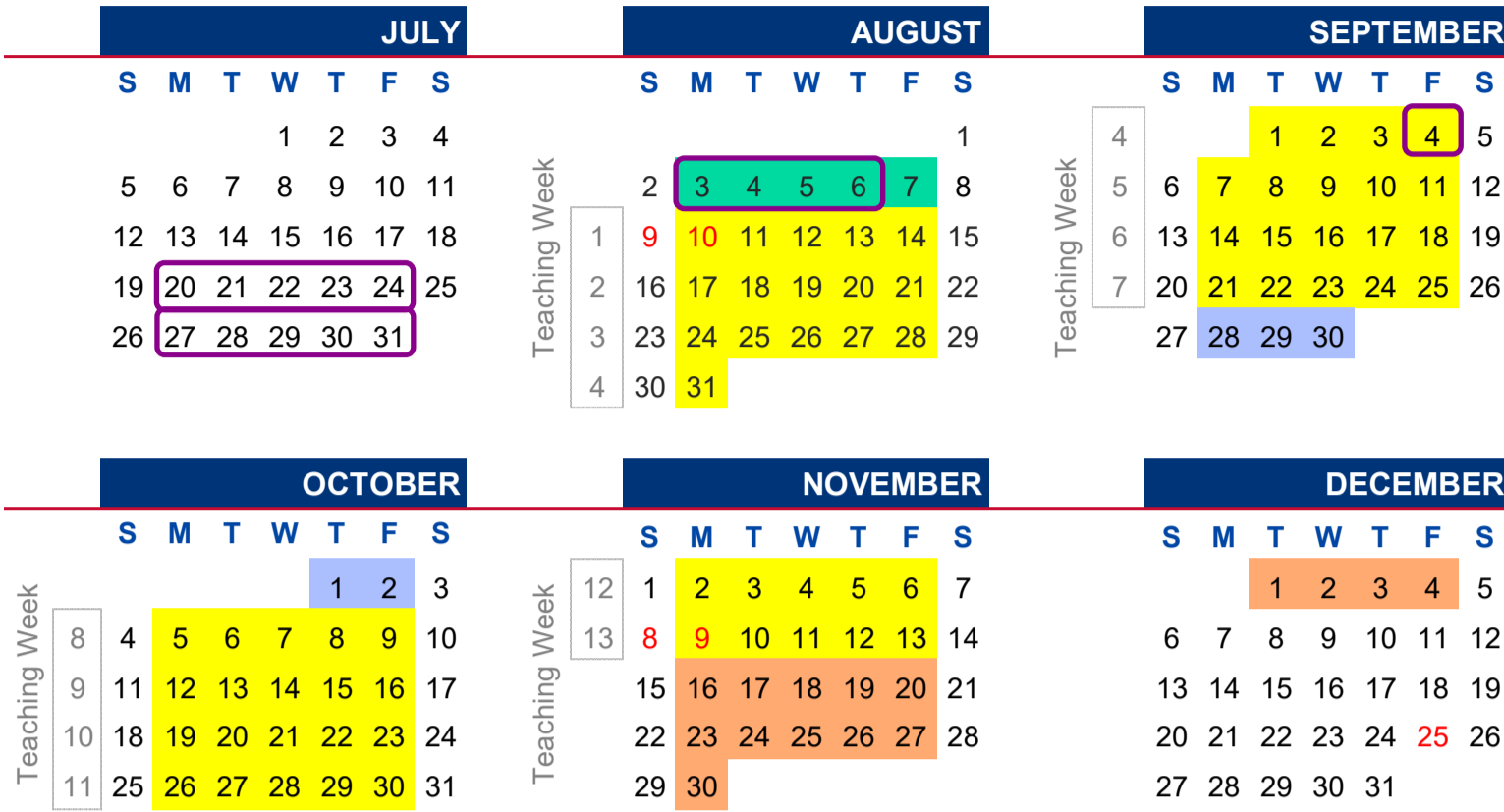

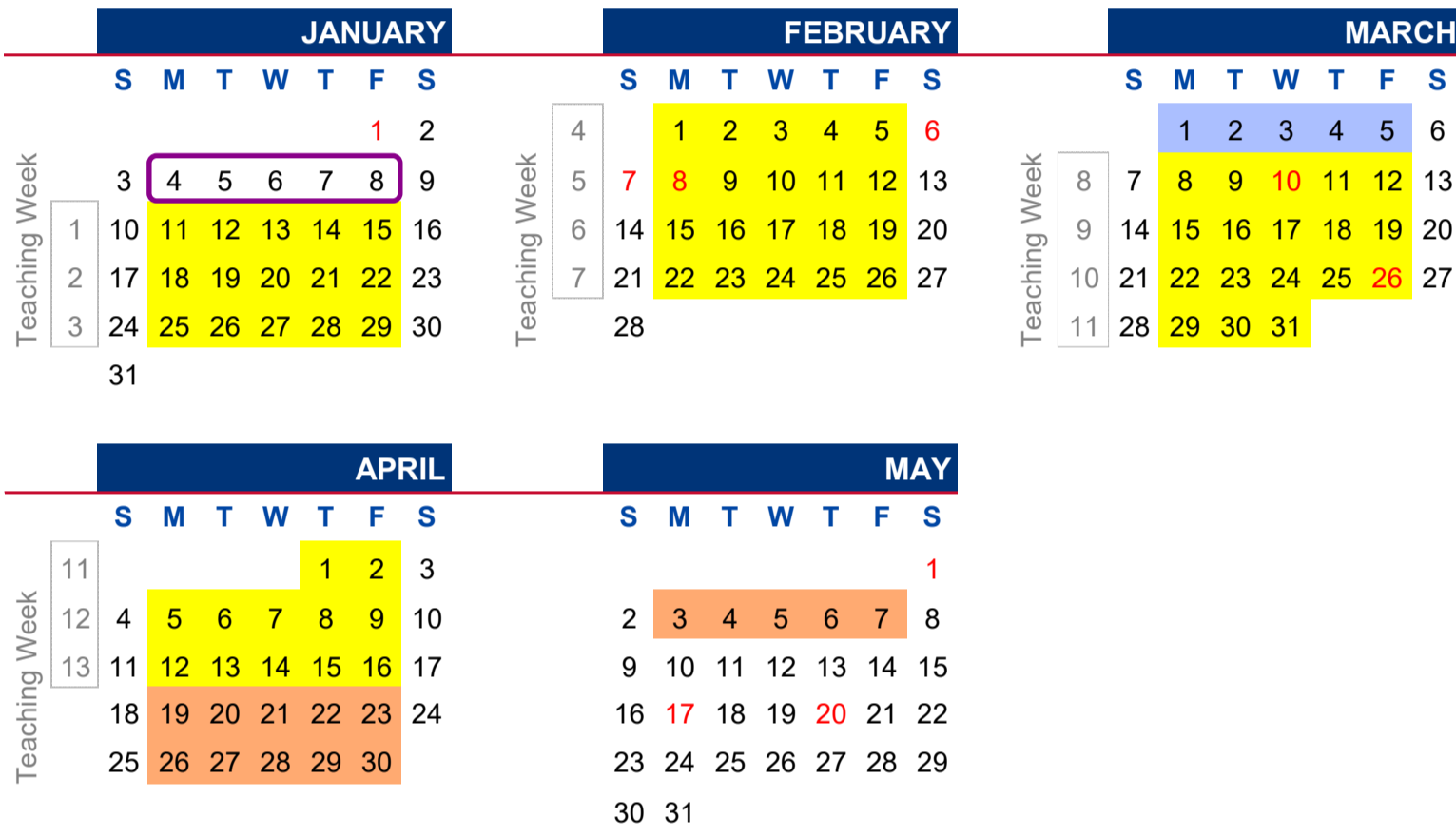

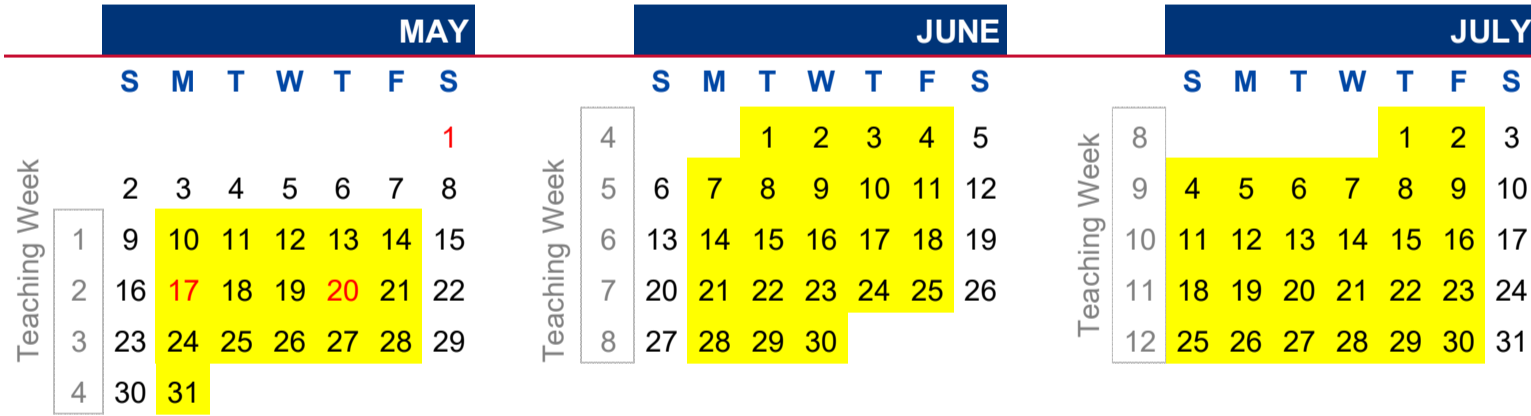
Public holiday dates are marked in red on the calendar.
